Culture Work

 - Ensure one quarter tank of fuel in trucks at all times.
 - Ensure that trucks are in good repair, report safety or repair concerns to the Logistics Manager.

Working conditions

Flexible scheduling; some on-call availability; may have to work outdoors in inclement weather; drive large box truck; operate small equipment with dexterity.
