Duties and responsibilities

Culture Work

- Establish professional, caring, strengths-based relationships built on truth, respect, encouragement and trust.
- Maintain a high level of integrity in modeling and promoting the Mission's core values and culture standards.
- Skillfully help to lead, develop, promote and sustain a spiritual climate within The Rescue Mission in keeping with our purpose, calling and culture.

Team Work

- Work as a member of the senior leadership team to:
 - help establish organizational strategies, policies and priorities
 - establish and manage budgets
 - o advise the Sr. Director of Operations & Outcomes in all matters
 - help solve organizational challenges
 - o proactively assist as necessary in the overall success of the Mission

Direct Work

- Oversee the operations of the Facilities/Maintenance Department, including training, managing, evaluating, and growing a highly effective team of experts and leaders to achieve department goals and Mission objectives.
- Ensure teamwork and cooperation between various Mission departments.
- Train and coach staff and volunteers/interns to ensure the delivery of excellent customer service, in alignment with Mission core values, trauma-informed care and cultural competency.
- Ensure that Mission facilities provide a safe, secure, dignifying, well-maintained space in which to achieve program objectives:
 - Manage work request system and work schedule of repairs and improvements
 - Conduct necessary preventative maintenance on all buildings and maintain preventative maintenance records on all buildings.
 - Supervise and coordinate all purchasing of materials needed to maintain all buildings and departments.
- Coordinate and supervise all new construction and remodel work when assigned by the Sr. Director of Operations & Outcomes.
- Oversee vehicle fleet maintenance
- Oversee and coordinate contractors and sub-contractors working on buildings and maintain records on work completed.
- Work with all municipal agencies and departments to maintain buildings and meet all city and county building codes.
- Schedule facility staff for funder site visits and inspections.
- Manage budgets for maintenance and transportation/vehicles.



- Work with TRM Administration in all matters pertaining to personnel and purchasing.
- Work with TRM Community Engagement Department in building partnerships, assisting with donation drives and tracking/receipting donations.
- Work with TRM program leadership to ensure cross-training of staff and to foster great teamwork.
- Attend all required Mission meetings and training events, and represent the Mission in meetings within the community.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Sr. Director of Operations & Outcomes and/or as necessary to support TRM's mission.

Working conditions

Varied; some office work and some travel between locations required; may be required to be outdoors in inclement weather and/or work irregular hours to properly lead and supervise staff and work. Interact with a variety of people, including clients who may have high barriers, including but not limited to people suffering from mental illness and/or people who may be under the influence of drugs/alcohol.
