- Must be able to make decisions in a rational and thoughtful way
- Must be able to handle emergency situations adequately
- Be prompt to your committed schedule

- Length of Season: No required commitment
- Orientation required prior to first volunteer shift

Job Description

- Along with TRM Staff, load van with sandwiches, snacks, water, hygiene items, etc
- Along with TRM Staff, travel throughout Pierce County to encampments to offer food, drink, basic supplies to those living in the encampments
- Along with TRM Staff, talk to, pray with, build relationships with those living in the encampments
