Reggie came to the Mission when he was at the end of his rope. Reeling from the loss of two of his loved ones. Suicidal. And hungry for food and safe community.

"I started coming to the Mission maybe two or three times a week for meals," Reggie shares. "I could always come here and feel safe and secure. It was a place where I knew I was going to be okay."

Today, Reggie is surrounded by a healing community, living in stability, experiencing restoration on his recovery journey, and on the road to a whole new life.

"[The Mission wants] to help you, they want you to eat, they want you to be a part of something bigger."




